Ten Little Aliens

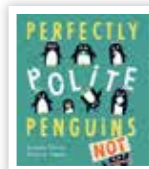
Count from ten to one and back again in this rhyming space story. This early counting book lends itself to sharing and joining in. Great fun.

The Colour Monster goes to School

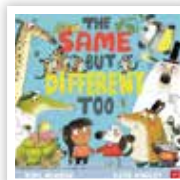
The Colour Monster is worried about going to school for the first time. He doesn't know what to expect. However he soon discovers that school can be fun. A reassuring story.

Sharing books with your child is fun and the best start for school you could give them.

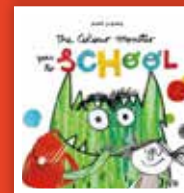

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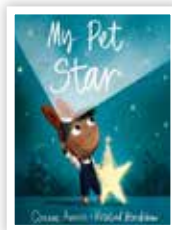

Scaredy Cat

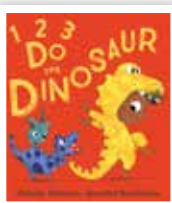
A story of a girl and her beloved pet who is scared of many things. A bouncy rhyming story that is a delight to read aloud.

1, 2, 3, Do the Dinosaur

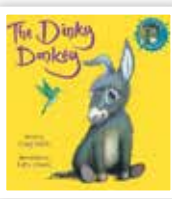
A young boy takes on the task of teaching dinosaurs how to act like a dinosaur. Plenty of opportunity for joining in with the actions in this hilarious story.

Dinosaur Day Out

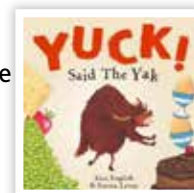

All You Need is Love

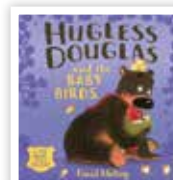
A young dog learns that new friends can be a good thing. A useful story for promoting new friendships. Great fun.
