

Admissions Policy

Conker Club is the name of the After School Club at North Farnborough Infant School, providing safe, creative care and play. Conker Club is registered with Ofsted for a maximum number of 40 children at any one session. Conker Club was first set up to aid working parents.

Admission Criteria

- 1. Children who are in attendance at North Farnborough Infant School.
- 2. All places must be booked in advance with the Conker Club Administrator. Once a place is allocated it will be available for that child until it is no longer required. This is known as a regular booking. It can only be cancelled in writing, giving at least one months notice.
- 3. Priority for places will be given to working parents but if there are spaces, non-working parents may book up to two weeks in advance. Each session must be paid monthly in advance until written notice is received that the place is no longer required.
- 4. The Conker Club Administrator must be notified, preferably in writing, of any alterations to bookings.
- 5. 'Casual use' is actively encouraged and these places are allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis when spaces are available.
- 6. All parents are required to fill in an application form in order to book a place at the Club giving contact and medical details.
- 7. Children who have a sibling already attending Conker Club will be given priority.
- 8. The Conker Club keeps a waiting list for when the maximum numbers have been reached for a session. These places will be allocated using the above criteria should a space become available.
- 9. Places that become available at short notice due to illness are posted daily on the whiteboard outside and parents on the waiting list contacted in order.
- 10. Conker Club reserves the right to cancel or refuse future bookings if payments for sessions are not made in advance. (See Charging Policy).
- 11. Conker Club reserves the right to cancel or refuse future bookings if a child is not collected punctually, before 6pm. (see Policy for Collecting Children).
- 12. All bookings are non-transferable and non-refundable.
- 13. In the event of an emergency, Conker Club reserves the right to cancel the Service, and inform parents as soon as possible.
