### **Democracy**

At Conker Club we work together to create our (Golden Rules) and the rights associated with these. These are included in all our play activities. Some of these rules are based on the UN convention on the Rights of a Child which are regularly in evidence during our sessions. During show & tell, one-to-one & group discussions at these times and in general play children's ideas and concerns are voiced and acted upon.

### **The Rule of Law**

The rules that govern our country, our club are very important and are consistently reinforced at Conker Club. Our children are taught the importance of rules. The children understand the values and the reasons behind these rules, this helps them understand their responsibilities and the consequences when rules are broken. In this way we encourage them to make good choices.

## **Mutual Respect**

Through Conker Club Council, show & tell, children learn that their behaviour and actions affect themselves, others and the environment. Children discuss & write their own rules and this gives them the opportunity to gain an understanding of issues that affect other people, in other places. It also encourages them to find ways in which they can make a positive effect on the lives of others and the environment.

## **Tolerance of those of different Faiths and Beliefs**

Children who have different faiths are encouraged to share their experiences and knowledge so that everyone's understanding is enhanced.

We have regular, themed weeks which develop children's understanding of different cultures. At show & tell time we promote discussion and understanding of different ways of living.
