Make collages of Minibeasts and display as a shared artwork.	<u>Making Birds</u> Sculptural project beginning with making drawings from observation, exploring media, and transforming the drawings from 2d to 3d to make a bird.
Year 2	<u>Explore & Draw</u> Introducing the idea that artists can be collectors & explorers as they develop drawing and composition skills.	<u>Exploring the World Through Mono Print</u> Using a simple mono print technique to develop drawing skills, encourage experimentation and ownership.	<u>Be An Architect</u> Exploring architecture and creating architectural models.
