Communication, Language and Literacy

- Recognising and using numerals 1-5.
- Subitise numbers up to 5.
- Count a range of objects saying one number name for each.
- Select the correct numeral to represent objects.

Physical Development

- Pincer grip activities to support muscle development in fingers.
- Hand muscle development activities.
- mark making using different materials.
- Water and paintbrush activities outside developing upper arm strength.
- Developing independence putting on own coat.
- Movement and navigating space safely in PE lessons

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Learning new routines.
- Making new friends.
- Playing games taking turns and listening to others.
- How to keep each other and ourselves safe in school - class rules and managing own hygiene.
