

Year 2 - Spring 2 Curriculum Map

Writing: We will be looking at books all about different adventures. We will first look at 'Man on the Moon' and 'The Way Back Home'. We will be writing a recount of Bob's day and creating character descriptions of the missing boy.

Handwriting: This will be a big focus throughout the year. Children will be encouraged to form letters correctly, ensuring consistent size and shape. Please practise lower and upper case handwriting at home.

Read, Write Inc: Children will continue with the Read, Write Inc. programme, remaining on the colours from Year 1. They will be reassessed at the end of half term and may move colour groups if appropriate.

Guided Reading: Once children complete Read, Write Inc., they will begin whole class guided reading. This involves exploring and unpicking a variety of texts, deepening skills such as inference, prediction, and making links.

In Maths, we will be learning to read and write numbers in numerals and words, order numbers, and count forwards and backwards up to 100, including crossing tens boundaries and counting in 3s. We will develop confidence with addition and subtraction by using number facts, partitioning, part-whole models, and understanding the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction. We will solve one-step problems using concrete resources, number lines, and pictorial representations, and learn how to check our answers. We will also interpret and create simple tally charts, block diagrams, and tables to organise and understand information.

'Out of This World'



In Music, we will learn to read notation, use dynamics effectively, and perform Glockenspiel pieces with confidence and creativity.

In Computing, we will be learning how to include photos, text, and sound in our digital creations, and how to use a range of different programs together to organise information clearly and effectively.

In PSHE, we will continue to follow the new 'My Happy Mind'

In PE, we will be doing sending and receiving and gymnastics.

In RE, we will be learning about 'Palm Sunday' in this unit and will be learning what it is, why it is important to Christians and how it is celebrated/ remembered.

In Geography, we will be using world maps and globes to identify the continents, the equator and the oceans. We will name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans and recap the four countries and capital cities in the UK and locate them on a map.

In Science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We will be sorting things into categories such as living, dead and never alive. To know what a habitat is and how animals adapt to these environments in order to survive, as well as understanding simple food chains learning key concepts such as a producer and a consumer.

In Art, we will be exploring the work of an artist who uses mono printing, learning a simple mono print technique, and developing our mono printing and drawing skills. We will be encouraged to take creative risks and use drawing playfully to invent ideas and create our own narratives.



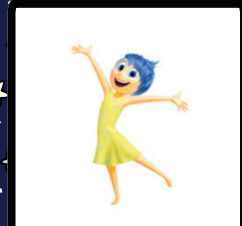
